Colorado Gulch (6)

2 - D1.5 on E at 6300'

Above the Big Wood River 4 - D1.5-2 on E at 6100'

Patterson Peak (3)

Above Woodside 3 - D2 on N-NW at 6800-7300'

Croy Canyon (13)

Bullion Gulch (Pk. 8435') 3 - D2 on E-SE at 7400-8200' 35-45°

Kelly Peak 1 - D2 on E at 8500' 32-34°

Kelly Gulch 3 - D1.5-2 on E-NE at 6200' 32-34°

Della Peak 1 - SS-ASu-D2 on NW at 6500' 32-34°

5- D1.5-2 on E at 6000-6600'

Many small wind slabs

*most larger slabs were Persistent Slabs 1-3' crowns

Carbonate Mountain (7)

7 - D1.5-2 on E at 6000-6500' Wind Slabs 1-2' crowns

Deer Creek (7)

Pk 7254 4 - D1.5-2 6600-7000' Persistent Slab 1-2' crowns

Narrow Gauge Gulch 3 - D2 on N-E at 7000-8400' 32-34°

Greenhorn (9)

8 - D1.5 on N at ~6300' 32-35° Persistent Slabs 1-2' crowns

1 - D2 on an E-SE slope far out from the summer trailhead

East Fork (6)

Mine Benders 6 - D2 on W-NW-N at 7600-7800'; one hit the valley floor, and another two came to a rest before the river

KOA chutes (2)

2 - D1.5 on E at 6800'

Dollarhide/Warm Springs area (at least 12)

Basset Gulch many D1.5 on E-NE

2 - D2 on SE

1 - D2 on E with very wide crown

Cathedral Pines (1)

1 - D2 on NE at 7800'

West Fork Prairie Creek (1)

1 - D2 on E at 9600'

Galena Pass (2)

Westernhome Gulch 1 - D2 on W at 9000'

Governors Punchbowl 1 - D2 on NE at 9000'

Salmon Headwaters (2)

2 - D2 on E at 8200'; remote from snowmobilers? There were tracks near the ridgeline.

Saviors Peak north cirque 3 - D2 on N at 9800-10,200' on a Persistent Slab

Owl Creek (2)

1 - D2 on E at 9600' (determined from a public observation) 2-3' crown

1 - D2 on N at 9000' in the "Austrian Chutes" 2' crown

Loose Dry activity on Saviers Peak

Horton Peak (1)

1 - D1 Wind Slab on NW
